[Romain Deles](#) is Associate Professor at [Université de Bordeaux](#) and a researcher at [Centre Emile Durkheim \(UMR CNRS 5116\)](#). He has a PhD in Sociology (Université de Bordeaux) and published a book entitled *Quand on n'a "que" le diplôme... Les jeunes et leur insertion professionnelle*, Paris, PUF (2018). He currently works on graduate studies and transition to employment for young people in Europe. With a colleague, [Nicolas Charles](#), he produced a report for the [CNESCO](#) (Centre National d'Étude des Systèmes Scolaires), the evaluation body of the French school system, on selection in higher education in different European countries, including Sweden.

ACTIVITIES IN SWEDEN

Romain Deles' stay in Sweden aimed to meet researchers working in Sociology and Education at [Stockholm University](#) to set up a collaboration on the question of the experience of youth and professional transition in France and Sweden. There, he met [Elisabeth Hultqvist](#), [Carina Carlhed Ydhag](#) and [Ali Osman](#), Associate Professors at the [Department of Education](#), Stockholm University. They discussed a protocol of sociological research, common to both countries, as part of a future international comparison of youth experiences and transition to employment. They also had the opportunity to discuss the construction of a partnership between [ESPE Aquitaine](#) (Université de Bordeaux) and Stockholm University, aiming at future research mobilities between both universities.
