PRESENTATION

Lars E. Eriksson is a Professor of [Nursing Sciences](#) at [Karolinska Institutet](#) (Stockholm). His research focuses on biobehavioural and translational nursing aspects on health and quality of life of people living with long-lasting conditions. He has a clinical affiliation to the Unit of Infectious Diseases at [Karolinska University Hospital](#) and is also a part-time Professor in Nursing at the [School of Health Sciences](#) at [City, University of London](#).

ACTIVITIES IN FRANCE

Lars E. Eriksson had established contact with the [URC-ECO](#) research group at [Hotel Dieu, Université Paris Cité](#). His visit in the group gave him plenty opportunities for mutual discussions on areas of common interest such as patient reported outcomes or health-related stigma. He also provided project support and consultations to PhD students and postdocs. His stay will result in his engagement as a co-author of at least three manuscripts and several potential research proposals, such as on the topics of early signs and symptoms of lung cancer or quality of sexual life for people living with HIV or hepatitis C infection.

He also attended several meetings with colleagues, for example at the [Groupe de Recherche Famiréa](#) (experience of families of patients in Intensive Care Units), [Hôpital Saint Louis](#) (Paris). Discussions were held about nursing as an academic subject with [Dr. Kentish-Barnes](#) and two French fellow nurse researchers. A future research collaboration was discussed between them.
