He previously carried out research works at the [Universität des Saarlandes](#) in Saarbrücken and at the [Pierre and Marie Curie Campus](#) at [Sorbonne University](#). He graduated 1999 with a PhD degree in Molecular Chemistry at Toulouse University and his research interests include among others metallic oxide-based materials and biomass valorisation using organic solvent free process.

ACTIVITIES IN SWEDEN

During his stay in Sweden, Dominique Agustin had the opportunity to visit four universities and to meet with numerous researchers.
