PRESENTATION

[Ann-Zofie Duvander](#) is Professor of Demography at the [Department of Sociology](#) at [Stockholm University](#), where she graduated with a PhD degree in Sociology and Demography. She is also Professor at [Mid Sweden University](#). Her research interests include family policy and parent leave policies in Sweden with a focus on leave taken by fathers. She studied for instance the family and work-connection and income trajectories in couples following childbirth as well as older couples' relationship. Ann-Zofie Duvander has been involved in comparative Nordic and international studies and she was one of the two coordinators of the [International Network for Leave policies and Research](#) until 2021.

ACTIVITIES IN FRANCE

Ann-Zofie Duvander participated in a discussion at [INED](#), the National Institute for Demographic Studies, on her study concerning adult's children propensity to provide personal care to older parents in Sweden by gender of adult child, parental breakup in childhood and parent's living arrangements. She also took part in a conference at INED on ageing couples and the associated economic consequences.

Moreover, she visited the [IRES](#), Social and Economic Research Institute, where she had the opportunity to be involved in a discussion entitled "Incentive or obstacle? The use of parental leave of immigrant mothers and the following labour market activity."

During her stay, four major projects, including a collaboration on "Economic consequences of divorce at older ages" and another one on "Child penalty and care giving benefit in the pension system", were initiated with different researchers including [Carole Bonnet](#), [Benoit Rapoport](#), [Nathalie Le Bouteillec](#) and [Roméo Fontaine](#).

Finally, Ann-Zofie Duvander travelled to Geneva to participate in the celebrations of the 100 years of maternity protection at the International Labour Organisation ([ILO](#)).
