His research works focus mainly on Artificial Intelligence, video & image segmentation, and assistive technology for impairment people.

During her stay at [KTH](#) and [Stockholm University](#), Anis Rojbi had the opportunity to present her research works and to raise awareness of the importance of addressing the problems of people with disabilities using technology and innovation and to discover the research topics developed by the Swedish groups.
