ACTIVITIES IN SWEDEN

Samuel Roturier met with several researchers from the [SLU](#), Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences, including [Lars Östlund](#), [Sarah Cogos](#), [Torbjörn Josefsson](#), Urban Bergsten and [Charoltte Erefur](#), Head of the [experimental station of Vindeln](#).

The main objective of this mobility was the discussion and supervision of the PhD degree of Sarah Cogos on Fire management and reindeer herding in the Malå district during the 20th century.

Two potential collaborations have been also discussed. The first one is a restoration project of lichen moors with Urban Bergsten and the other one concerns dendrochronology with Torbjörn Josefsson. She had indeed carried out with him in winter an analysis of samples taken in Patagonia.
