He obtained his PhD in Ethnicity and International Migration from [Linköping University](#) and the [REMESO](#) division of migration, ethnicity and society in 2015. He is interested in local development, social policy and specialist in housing policy for vulnerable groups.

ACTIVITIES IN FRANCE

Foutier visited the Laboratory Migrations and Society ([URMIS](#)) in Paris, a mixed research unit between the [University Paris Cité](#), [University Côte d'Azur](#), the Institute of Research for Development ([IRD](#)), and the French National Center of Scientific Research ([CNRS](#)), with the aim to initiate Master exchanges between URMIS and REMESO divisions, increase scientific collaboration, and establish joint teaching frameworks for the professors and lecturers of the respective institutions. Two Swedish researchers engaged in health and migration research had already visited the URMIS, were they taught several classes. A joint application for a European project was envisaged. He also had the opportunity to attend an international conference on Violence and Migration.
