PRESENTATION

[Johan Martinsson](#) is Associate Professor at the [Department of Political Science](#) of the [University of Gothenburg](#) and Research Director of the Laboratory of Opinion Research and the [Citizen Panel](#). He is interested in voting behavior, survey methodology and environmental attitudes. He obtained his PhD in Political Science from the University of Gothenburg in 2009.

ACTIVITIES IN FRANCE

Martinsson visited the Center for Political Research ([CEVIPOF](#)) at the Institut d'Études Politiques de Paris ([Sciences Po Paris](#)). He was hosted by [Martial Foucault](#), Director of CEVIPOF and part of the [CIRANO](#) (Centre Interuniversitaire de Recherche en Analyse des Organisations). They exchanged views on their common projects concerning economic voting and patrimonial economic voting, and tabled a joint publication that would be complemented by Swedish data. On that topic, they also discussed how they could improve their data collection methodology.

Martinsson also held a presentation on the use of online panels for collection survey data at the CEVIPOF in conjunction with a full-day seminar planning the French election studies for 2017. Following the presentation, he had a meeting on web panels with [Anne Jadot](#), manager of the research panel [ELIPSS](#) (now at the [University of Lorraine](#) and the Institut de Recherches sur l'Évolution de la Nation et de l'État [IRENEE](#)), and with the statistician [Jean Chiche](#), researcher at CEVIPOF and part of the scientific committee of [CESP](#), auditing and reporting on surveys mainly focused on media audiences in France.

Furthermore, he deliberated with [Sylvain Brouard](#), with whom he shares research interests in agenda setting, issue saliency, public agenda and issue ownership of parties, with [Pavlos Vasilopoulos](#) (now at [the University of York](#)), a scholar of green party voting in Europe and close to Martinsson's interest in environmental attitudes, and with [Steven van Hauwaert](#) ([Forward College Paris](#)), with whom he planned a future collaboration on mappings of issue ownership development across Europe.
