The ÖMSE mobility was carried out in conjunction with the defense of her co-tutored PhD thesis in Political Science and Government by [Farhad Khosrokhavar](#) at the [EHESS](#) and [Karin Aggestam](#) at Lund University in 2015. She is now Deputy Director of the [Arab Reform Initiative](#) in Paris. Her research focuses on social movements and alternative forms of political engagement in the Arab region, on patterns and factors influencing youth mobilization and civic and political participation.

ACTIVITIES IN SWEDEN

Sarah Anne Rennick made several monthly consecutive trips to Lund towards the end of her PhD on the Egyptian revolutionary and politicized youth. The “co-tutelle” thesis mobilized Lund University’s strong focus on Political Science and EHESS’ [Cadis laboratory](#)’s specialization on social movements. The defense of her thesis took place on 5 June 2015 at Lund University. After this, she was keen on pursuing the French-Swedish research collaborations in the area. She is actively promoting this at the Arab Reform Initiative, a French think-tank, where she is now deputy director.
